What does it cost?

AFFILIATION FEE (Includes GST)

This fee can be paid with your affiliation forms, or on Book Night, **but definitely by the first match.** There are no weekly fees. We believe we have very reasonable costs.

INSURANCE

The Association has compulsory player insurance, for all team

Each team must pay \$67 per team per competition this includes your umpire.

BOOK NIGHT

WE DO NOT POST THESE OUT

Everyone is asked to collect these.

Each team receives a program book, registration form, and invoice.

The program book has information you need to play. It also has the rules of the Association so read them carefully.

Contact details for the Committee; and contact details for all of the teams (just in case you need to contact one of them for forfeits, etc)

We ask a representative from each club/team to come to

Do you need an umpire?

YES Most definitely. If there are no umpires, there can be no game, so each team needs to supply one umpire per match

Umpires for all nights will be doing their own team - known as "home and home umpiring".

Even if your umpire can't turn up on the night, an umpire is required - so one of your players or a parent will have to umpire. **The summer committee allocates umpires for finals.** You will be asked to supply umpires.

Scorers

Each team must supply a scorer. The scorers <u>must sit together</u> so there are no disagreements on scores. A player will need to leave the court if there is no one else. Bring out supporters.

Car Park

Car parking is permitted in the car park adjacent to the courts. Enter via Anzac Highway or Goodwood Road,

Parking within the designation area only

No parking is permitted near the courts or clubrooms unless with a permit. Disable parking with permit is allowed the northern side of the clubrooms.





Hot Weather Policy

Matches for the night will be cancelled if the temperature is 36 or more and it will announced on Facebook and our web site by 4.30 pm on the day of matches

N.B. The ACC keeps the gates locked to the car park. They will be opened prior to the commencement of matches, and will be locked approx 20 mins after the last match. Please make sure all cars are removed by then.

Equipment

Unfortunately, you need more than just seven people. Don't forget the following:

- X uniform for everyone (see below) Shorts are not permitted
- X a set of bibs (playing positions)
- X a ball
- X first aid kit and ice
- X A scorer A person over 14 years of age A player will need to be taken off if not supplied
- X A timer (if you're in the finals)
- X A lot of **friendly supporters**!!!!

That reminds me - if you have your cheer squad on hand - their behaviour is the team's responsibility - that is keep them in line when they start giving the umpires a hard time (but I trust they won't in the first place)

Score Cards

- X Each team collects their scorecard from inside the clubrooms.
- X The first named team (white) second named team (blue)
- X The winning team of the match takes the completed score cards back to the clubrooms
- X (Pretty simple, isn't it!)

Pole Covers

- X The home team of the first match of each night, needs to make sure that the pole covers are collected from the Clubrooms and put on each pole
- X The home team of the last match of the night needs to do the opposite (that's right put them away)
- X A fine of \$20 will be imposed if pole covers are not returned to the clubrooms

Uniforms

- X no white uniforms
- X no bike pants (the marketed "sports briefs" or boy leg pants are OK)
- X player playing position letters (bibs)
- X uniforms need to be the same shade of colour (not 7 different shades of blue!)
- X no jewellery piercings or adornments -- body, hair etc
- X short fingernails gloves are permitted but nails must be short!!!
- X no lacy or bikini briefs
